Encourage the love of BBQ in your kids! Children 6-16 are invited to compete in the Kids-Q competition at the Berkeley Lions Club BBQ Cook Off - SBN Invitational. Children will have the opportunity to grill and compete just like the competition cook teams. We will supply the meat and serving trays/boxes, but you will have to use your own grill and/or equipment and bring seasonings, garnishes, and anything else they would like to use to enhance their presentation and creativity. See attached rules and regulations. There is no entry fee. Completed applications are due by October 1, 2023. Kids can check in on Friday November 3 between 3 and 4 PM with their parent/guardian.

Kids' Que Competition Rules

A parent or guardian must be present at all times to assist with the grill. Please let the children take lead on how they want to cook and prepare their meat.

Cooks Meeting

1. Each contestant, their parent or guardian must be present on Friday for a meeting at 5:00 pm. At the SBN Tent.

RULES:

A. Junior Group

1. Each contestant will receive 2 pounds of ground beef to be used in any manner they wish. Meat will be passed out after the 5:00 meeting. Only the meat provided can be used, no substitutions. Not all of the meat is required to be turned in.
2. Ground beef must be cooked to a minimum internal temperature of 130°.
3. Contestants can use any accompaniments, for example if they are doing a hamburger, buns, dressing, lettuce, tomato, ketchup, mustard, etc. are permissible.
4. Garnishing is permitted, but the meat must be the focus
5. No foreign matter (foil, plastic, toothpicks, etc.). Skewers will be allowed. All other items submitted must be edible, except for the skewers.
6. Contestants may use the product in any manner, but must be turned in complete. Judges should not be expected to cut or assemble the entry after turn in.
7. Turn in time will be 7 PM on Friday November 3 with a 10-minutes window (5 minutes before, and 5 minutes after). No late entries will be accepted. Competitors must turn in their entry only on the pre-numbered trays provided for them at the cooks meeting.
8. One full size sample is to be turned in to be judged for appearance, with (8) additional individual samples (for example, 1 complete hamburger and 2 additional full size hamburgers cut into 4 samples each, or eight (8) individual sliders). **All samples must be the same.**
9. The location of the turn in table will be announced at the cooks meeting.
10. Contestants are responsible for abiding by all Rules and Regulations. Failure to do so will be cause for disqualification

B. Senior Group

1. Each contestant will receive 2 pork tenderloins following the 5:00 meeting. Only the meat provided can be used, no substitutions. Not all of the meat is required to be turned in.
2. Pork must be cooked to an internal temperature of 165°.
3. Contestants can use spices, and accompaniments.
4. Garnishing is permitted, but the meat must be the focus
5. No foreign matter (foil, plastic, toothpicks, etc.). Skewers will be allowed. All other items submitted must be edible, except for the skewers.
6. Contestants may use the product in any manner, but must be turned in complete. Judges should not be expected to cut or assemble the entry after turn in.
7. Turn in time will be 7:30 PM on Friday November 3 with a 10-minutes window (5 minutes before, and 5 minutes after). No late entries will be accepted.
8. Eight (8) individual samples/pieces (examples medallions) must be turned in. **All samples must be the same.**
9. Competitors must turn in their entry in the pre-numbered 9x9 foam box provided for them at the cooks meeting. Should your box get damaged, see SBN Event Rep for a new box.
10. The location of the turn in table will be announced at the cooks meeting.
11. Contestants are responsible for abiding by all Rules and Regulations. Failure to do so will be cause for disqualification

Contestants are responsible for the clean-up of their assigned cooking area. Trash, ash, and grease must be placed in appropriate designated disposal areas..

Judging/Awards

Judging will be based on the following criteria: Appearance, Aroma/Taste, and Texture/Tenderness. Scoring will be on the same scale as the BBQ judging, 1 – 10 with 10 being the highest. Grand and Reserve Grand Champions in each group will receive awards. Awards will be presented during the awards ceremony on Saturday at 3:30 pm.
