This is a three (3) meat competition event, sanctioned by the Southern BBQ Network (SBN). Registration is \$250 per professional cook off team and \$200 per amateur cook off team. Please read the rules and regulations thoroughly. We look forward to seeing you in August 2023! Awards will be announced at 2 PM on Saturday, August 19, 2023.

The Castle Cook Off will have the following Categories:

"Boston Butts" winning trophies and cash awards totalling \$1000

"Pork Ribs" winning trophies and cash awards totalling \$1000

"Chicken" winning trophies and cash awards totalling \$1000

"Grand Champion" and "Reserve Grand Champion" winning trophies and cash awards of \$500

"Castle Choice" (Fan Favorite) cookers competing in Butts, Ribs or Chicken are eligible to win trophy and cash award of \$250

"Fruit Smoothie" winning trophies and cash awards of \$200

### **Contest Rules and Regulations**

- 1. A cooking team representative is required to attend the mandatory cooks meeting at 5:30pm on Friday, August, 18, 2023.
- 2. Wristbands for head cooks and assistants must be worn at all times during the event. Only those with wrist bands will be allowed in the event area before 8 a.m. on Saturday, August 19, 2023.
- 3. Teams are responsible for passing out samples. Help will be provided as needed and if available.
- 4. Grills/cookers must be set up outside of the tent, in compliance with our fire code.
- 5. Meat may be prepared on any type of cooker.
- 6. Teams must adhere to prudent temperature and sanitary requirements as specified by SCDHEC.

You may access a copy of the SCDHEC guidelines for food service at special events at the following web link, or by visiting your local SCDHEC office for a hard copy of the information. Go to www.scdhec.gov/food and click on Regulation 61-25. Be sure to take a look at Chapter 9 (specifically 9-9) for event specific information. Also, take a look through their fact sheets listed on www.scdhec.gov/food for great food safety information.

- 7. All meat will be served by the cook teams as samples starting at 10 a.m. on Saturday.
- 8. Forks, napkins, and soufflé cups will be provided.
- 9. Teams are to serve samples from tents that must have weights attached to each leg.
- 10. Foam containers will be provided for judging
- 11. Turn in will be Saturday at 9 a.m. for Boston Butts, 10 a.m. for Ribs and 11am for Chicken.
- 12. Only teams who compete in Boston Butts, ribs and chicken are eligible for Grand Champion and Reserve Grand Champion awards.
- 13. In addition to the Cook Off Contest rules stated, all competitors must follow SBN rules and regulations.

### **Boston Butts:**

- a. Each cook team will be given 6-8 butts on Friday, August 18, 2023 immediately following the cooks team meeting.
- b. All Butts used for judging must be cooked on site and will be supplied by Westwood High School Education Foundation.

#### Pork Ribs and Chicken:

a. Teams will furnish their own ribs (according to SBN guidelines) in an unopened package.

#### Check-In & Meat Inspection:

Friday August 18, 2023 from 5:00 pm 8:00 p.m. Teams will be allowed to set up immediately after their meat inspection. Meat Inspection will take place at your booth location upon your arrival.

Cooks Meeting: Friday August 18, 2023 @ 5:30 pm located at the Judges' Area/Tent.

#### **Team Code of Conduct:**

- a. The Head cook is responsible for the conduct of his/her team and guests.
- b. Teams must serve all prepared meat provided as samples/pounds/whole butt to the public. (after judging turn in).
- c. Teams must keep their area clean and free of trash and debris.
- d. Grease and ashes will be disposed of in the proper containers and taken with you for disposal. Failure to do so will result in a \$200 fine.
- e. Live animals are allowed on the campus before, during or after the event.
- f. Teams must have the following: hand washing station, soap, paper towels, bucket for disposal water, probe thermometer and fire extinguisher.
- g. Food prep and serving must be done under tents. All tents that cover or are close to cooking grills must be NFPA 701 flame retardant tents.
- h. All vehicles will be parked in designated cookers parking areas by 6 pm on August 18<sup>th</sup>. Vehicles not parked in cookers/vendors parking areas will be towed at the owner's expense. Only cooking/serving vehicles can be in the grill area.
- i. Quiet hours must be maintained from 12 a.m. Friday 6 a.m. Saturday.
- j. Under no circumstances are teams to distribute any alcoholic beverages to the public.
- k. All SBN rules and regulations apply. For a full list, visit sbbqn.com.
