



## Doko Rib Fest Cook Off in the Park

**Saturday - March 11, 2023**

### Cook Off Competition - Local Rules

1. All teams are asked to cook at least 15 racks of St. Louis cut Ribs.
2. Ribs are provided by the event organizers and will be passed out at 6:00 am on March 11, 2023.
3. Ribs may be cooked on gas, electric, pellet, charcoal, or wood grill or smoker.
4. You will need to pick out 3 racks for the contest for Southern Barbecue Network judges.
5. You will need to put at least 8 bones in your turn in box for judges to sample.
6. No garnish is allowed in your turn in box.
7. The rest of your ribs are for samples to the public with Doko Rib Fest tickets they have purchased beginning at 11:00 am. There will be one (1) tasting ticket for each one (1) rib sample per ticket. **Tokens will be provided for voting for one (1) People's Choice Award.**
8. We will provide you with your turn in box, sample boats, **People's Choice buckets and tokens.**
9. Turn in times:
  - a. **11:00 am - Amateur Division**
  - b. **12:00 pm - Veterans Division**
  - c. **1:00 pm - Professional Division**
10. There will be a winner's Trophy for the People's Choice in each of the Amateur, Professional, and Military Veterans Divisions. People's Choice Trophies will be awarded by a count of most **People's Choice tokens** are received by each team per Division. We will provide sample **cups**, napkins, and buckets for each team for **People's Choice tokens**.
11. All Division places and People's Choice Award winners will be announced at **5:30 pm** at the Amphitheater stage.
12. Judges' decisions are final.

3. You will need to reserve one sample of your Bloody Mary for the contest judging by event celebrity judges **not later than 7:00 am**.
4. Bloody Mary entries will be judged by the following criteria: Aroma, Appearance, Consistency, Taste, and Aftertaste.
5. **Prize Awards:** Current IRS Form W-9 required to issue monetary payment.

## **Keg Rolling Contest - 11:30 am - Local Rules**

1. A maximum of 16 individual contestant entries for the Keg Rolling Contest
2. 2 lines ("start/finish" and "turn around") will be marked in the contest area.
3. 4 kegs will be provided with one contestant per keg for each qualifying race.
4. Each contestant must roll their keg from the start line, past the turn around line and back to the finish line.
5. Fastest time to the finish line will qualify for the 2<sup>nd</sup> race competition.
6. The 4 qualifying winners will compete for playoff race competition.
7. The 2 fastest times in the playoff race competition will qualify for the championship race.
8. The fastest time in the championship race will be declared the over winner.

## **Log Sawing Contest - 1:00 pm - Local Rules**

1. A maximum of 8 Two Person Team contestant entries for the Log Sawing Contest
2. 2 saw bucks will be placed in the contest area with one log per saw buck with one contestant per team on each end of the Two Person saw provided.
3. Each contestant team will compete for the fastest time to complete their completed log cut.
4. Fastest time per team cut will qualify for the 2<sup>nd</sup> competition.
5. The 4 qualifying winners will compete for playoff competition.
6. The 2 fastest times in the playoff race competition will qualify for the championship contest.
7. The fastest time in the championship competition will be declared the over winner.

## **Keg Tossing Contest - 2:00 pm -Local Rules**

1. A maximum of 16 individual contestant entries for the Keg Tossing Contest
2. Competition toss line will be marked in the contest area.
3. 4 kegs will be provided with one contestant per keg for each qualifying toss.
4. Each contestant will make a horizontal toss toe the opposite end of the contest area.
5. The longest toss will qualify for the for each of the 4 kegs will qualify for 2<sup>nd</sup> toss competition.
6. The 4 qualifying winners will compete for playoff toss competition.
7. The 2 longest toss in the playoff toss competition will qualify for the championship toss.
8. The longest toss in the championship toss will be declared the over winner.
