

Kid's Q Rules

Contestant must attend the cooks meeting at 4 PM.

Meat

- a. Meat must be cooked to an internal temperature of 130 degrees.
 - b. Contestants can use any component, dressing, lettuce, tomato, ketchup, mustard, etc. Garnishing is permitted, but the meat must be the focus.
 - c. No foreign matter (foil, plastic, toothpicks, etc.) Skewers will be allowed. All items submitted must be edible except for the skewers.
 - d. Contestants may use the product in any manner, but must be turned in complete. In other words, we will not be expected to cut or assemble the entry after turn in.
2. Servings:
 - a. One full size sample to be judged for appearance.
 - b. Eight additional individual (smaller) samples for tasting. For example if they choose to do a sandwich they would need one regular size for appearance and two cut into fourths for samples.
 - c. The eight individual samples and the full size sample must be made from and contain the same products.
 3. Entries will be served on a 9 x 13 inch pre-numbered metal tray. Parchment paper will accompany the tray.
 4. Turn in times will be 6 PM. 5 minutes before to 5 minutes after. (This is a little flexible).
 5. They would be judged on the following criteria:
 - a. Appearance
 - b. Aroma/Taste
 - c. Texture/Tenderness
 6. Scoring would be on the same scale as our BBQ judging, 1 to 10 with 10 the highest.
